Age limits; **Peewee 2-5, Junior contestant 6-13, Senior contestant 14-18**

All-around points are awarded for 1st through 4th place only. No all-around points for Family Team Roping, and Peewee Events.

1st through 4th place points are determined by the number of entries received in each event and will be posted. In the event of a tie for All-around, a flip of the coin will decide the winner. In the event of a tie in the Jr / Sr rodeo events, a runoff will be held in that event to break the tie.

High School Rodeo rules are used as a guideline. Contestant numbers may be picked up at 7:30 A.M. from the announcer's booth. Jr & Sr events begin promptly at 8:30 A.M. ALL entrants MUST be ready at this time. Contestant's name will be called three (3) times, after which the stock will be turned out, or where no stock is involved, the event will proceed. Rodeo events and sections thereof will follow the order as listed in the program or as closely as possible. Ground Rules meeting at 8:00 A.M. near the announcer's booth.

- One buckle in each event category for girl or boy with best time. Best time for both JR/SR girl & boy used for all-around champion points.
 - Riders may use own rigging. Steer & Calf riding will have vests and helmets available.
 - SINGLE STEER STOPPING - one loop only.
 - BREAKAWAY - 30 second time limit. May carry second loop.
 - Jr. Rodeo TEAM ROPING - Three loops any way. Ropers go once.
 - Entries and fees for each roper must be received on separate entry by closing date or your name will be scratched.
 - FAMILY TEAM ROPING - Either parent/stepparent and child/stepchild. Three loops any way.
 - Juniors/Seniors enter once. Parent/stepparent may enter more than once with different child in Family Team Roping
 - Entry form event order is the order in which the events will occur in the Arena and Track
 - All around points factor in the number of contestants competing in each event.
 - Cash payback will be based on % of entry fees

RODEO RULES

Western attire including western hat or protective headgear is required. All contestants are encouraged to wear appropriate protective equipment. Tank tops, bare midriffs, shorts and/or similar attire will not be tolerated. Contestants caught drinking alcohol, using drugs, using inappropriate language or abusive treatment of livestock will be disqualified. **Contestants and parents are not allowed to talk to the judges unless requested by the judge.** If a problem arises, see the Arena Director. Numbers must be worn on contestants back at all times. All roping events will use "electronic barriers". **Only one entry per event.** Stock will be chute run. Names and sections will be posted at the bucking chutes. Roping stock will be chute run. No refunds will be given without a medical or vet certificate. **All mounted contestants will participate in Grand Entry opening ceremony.**
